

Cookies Policy

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small file which a website sends to your browser and saves on your computer when you visit a website. Cookies are used to ensure the website functions or to improve its performance, but also to supply information to website owners.

Based on the function and purpose of use, cookies can be classified into technical cookies, analytical cookies, profiling cookies, third party cookies.

Technical cookies

Technical cookies are those where the user's consent is not required. These cookies are crucial to surf a website and for its functions to be used. Without these cookies, which are absolutely necessary, a website could not supply some services or functions and browsing would not be smooth and easy as it should be. A cookie of this kind, moreover, is used to save the decision of the user on the use of cookies in the website.

Performance cookies are also part of this category which sometimes are also called analytics cookies. These are cookies which collect information on the use of a website by the user and which allow for its improvement. For example, performance cookies show which pages are visited more frequently, allow to track which are the recurring user patterns of a website, help understand any difficulty user encounters during use and show the efficacy of the advertising published on the website.

Technical cookies are crucial and cannot be disabled by using the functions of this website. Generally speaking, cookies can be completely deactivated from your own browser at any given moment.

Profiling cookies

Other cookies can be used to monitor or profile users while surfing, study their movements and habits for consulting the web or consumer habits (what they buy, what they read, etc.) even for the purpose of sending targeted and customized advertising.

These are profiling cookies. The use of these cookies requires the user's prior informed written consent pursuant to art. 23 Leg. Decree 196/2003.

This website does not use profiling cookies.

Third party cookies

It could also be possible that a web page has cookies coming from other websites and contained in the various elements hosted on the page itself like advertising banners, pictures, videos, etc. These are the so called third party cookies, which are usually used for profiling purposes.
